Who are the members?





The "Rainbow" project : Fighting against homophobia

ECFA partnered in the 'RAINBOW project', focusing on the right to sexual identity and the fight against homophobia.

The project's main objective is the development of knowledge about gender stereotypes and homophobia at all levels of education in Europe, amongst students and the adults who are responsible for their schooling.










- Lobby work
